The Third Eurasian Women's Forum will be held in compliance with a range of sanitary and epidemiological measures, which were proven to be effective at the St. Petersburg International Economic Forum 2021.

All Forum participants, media representatives and staff will be required to provide a negative result from a PCR test for COVID-19 in order to enter the Forum venue.

Measures in place include the treatment of vehicles and frequently touched surfaces with antiviral disinfectant, the use of pulsed xenon UV lights for air disinfection, the provision of personal protective equipment, and the calculation of business programme venue capacities in advance, taking into account levels of crowding at Forum venues.

We recommend that you arrive at the Forum venues in good time in view of the additional measures to prevent the spread of the novel coronavirus infection (COVID-19).

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ENTRY TO RUSSIA FOR FOREIGN PARTICIPANTS

Documents for crossing the border

In order to avoid any issues when crossing into the Russian Federation, please ensure that:

- You have provided information about your arrival to and departure from Russia through your <u>personal web office</u> at least 72 hours before boarding your plane
- You have a valid passport and a visa (if a visa is required for entry into the Russian Federation)
- You have a document (in Russian or English) confirming a negative PCR test result for COVID-19 dated at most 72 hours before your arrival in Russia
- You have a printed copy of your invitation letter to the Third Eurasian Women's Forum (or a letter about visa support) on your person
- You have proof of medical insurance coverage valid within the Russian Federation on your person

There is no quarantine upon arrival in Russia.

The absence of the printed copy of a Forum invitation, as well as the absence or inaccuracy of information in the personal web office **may be the reason for the refusal to board the plane or cross the border of the Russian Federation**.

Arrival information in the personal web office

All Forum participants that will be crossing a border into Russia, must indicate, at least 72 hours before boarding your plane, the following information in the 'Personal information' section of their <u>personal web office</u> in order to enter Russia:

- Country of departure
- Dates of arrival/departure
- Proposed point of entry into Russia (airport/rail terminal, city)
- Passport information (date of birth, citizenship, ID number)

In the 'COVID-19' section is necessary to indicate:

• Place of residence for the period of the Forum

We thank you for your patience and compliance with these measures. The organizers are asking participants to report information about their expected arrival and departure dates exclusively to comply with the security measures placed in order to combat the spread of the novel coronavirus infection (COVID-19) and facilitate your entrance into the Russian Federation.

When planning your arrival at the Forum, we strongly recommend booking direct flights.

Obtaining a visa for EAWF participants

Visitors holding an invitation to the Third Eurasian Women's Forum are eligible to obtain a shortterm single-entry visa for the period from 6 to 22 October 2021 using a simplified same-day procedure.

To apply for an entry visa to the Russian Federation, the invited person should contact the relevant Russian consular office abroad (information on the locations of the Russian Federation's consular offices can be found on the website of the <u>Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation</u>).

ARRIVAL IN ST. PETERSBURG

Luggage and customs

For safety reasons, carrying dangerous materials, objects and liquids in hand or checked luggage is prohibited.

Arrival by air. Pulkovo Airport

Pulkovo Airport (LED) is St. Petersburg's only airport that serves scheduled flights. Flights operate from Russian cities as well as several international cities.

The journey time from the airport to the Forum venues is approximately one hour (depending on the traffic).

CITY INFORMATION

Weather in St. Petersburg

St. Petersburg has a humid coastal climate. The average temperature at the middle of October can range from +6 $^{\circ}$ C to +10 $^{\circ}$ C.

Due to the city's geographic position and its proximity to the Baltic Sea an extreme change of weather is possible. We recommend EAWF guests to bring warm clothing and an umbrella with them.

Time zone

Local time in St. Petersburg is the same as in Moscow: three hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (UTC+3).

Power supply (socket types)

The power supply in Russia is 220V (50–60Hz). Type C and F sockets are common. If you plan to bring electrical appliances requiring a higher voltage or if you might need another socket type, we suggest you bring an adapter with you.

Mobile network

St. Petersburg operators offer a variety of mobile telecommunications services in the GSM, UMTS and LTE standards. Visitors to the city can purchase SIM cards from local mobile operators. All mobile operators provide mobile internet services.

Under Russian law, participants must be present in person and show a Russian or other passport in order to purchase a SIM card and sign a contract for mobile services.

Drawbridge schedule

There are drawbridges across the main waterways of St. Petersburg. If driving, bear in mind that at night it is not easy to get from one side of the river to the other because of the drawbridges. To avoid being stuck in one part of the city or having to use bypasses, please take note of the drawbridge schedule.

Participants are advised to buy a voluntary medical insurance policy for foreigners, which can be ordered in advance or purchased on arrival. Insurance for foreign citizens visiting Russia is a popular service offered by many insurance companies throughout the country.

ACCESS TO THE FORUM VENUES

Accessing the EAWF venues with a PCR test

All participants of EAWF 2021 and Forum events must undergo PCR testing for the novel coronavirus infection (COVID-19) to activate their badge.

In order to access the Forum venue from 08:00 on 13 October, participants must take a test at one of the dedicated EAWF testing centres **no earlier than 08:00 on 10 October and no later than 24 hours before arriving at the Forum venue**.

The result will automatically be sent to the Accreditation Centre. There is no need to submit the result of the PCR test. It is possible to receive an accreditation badge first and then take the test, or vice versa. The badge is activated after a negative result has been received, and will work until the end of the Forum. You do not need to register for PCR testing.

AN ACCREDITATION BADGE IS INVALID WITHOUT A NEGATIVE PCR TEST RESULT

Before going to the Forum venue, please make sure that your test result is negative

WHERE TO FIND YOUR ID

At the EAWF 2021 PCR testing centre, you will be **required** to show your ID (passport) and show your badge (if you have already received one), or give your member ID. The ID can be found in your <u>personal web office</u> (on the home page to the right from the photo).

It is **not possible** to upload data to the personal web office or activate the badge in order to access the event without first linking the test results to the participant ID.

PLENARY MEETING 14 OCTOBER

Attendees of the plenary session held on 14 October must undergo an additional PCR test on 13 October starting from 08:00 until 18:00 at a Forum testing centre exclusively.

For the convenience of participants in attendance at the venue, additional testing centres will be in operation at Tavricheskiy Palace and the Parliamentary Centre on 13 October.

INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 IMMUNITY

All Forum participants and media representatives **are required** to provide information about their immunity to COVID-19 in their <u>personal web office</u>.

- Information about previous COVID-19 status.
- Information about the presence or absence of COVID-19 antibodies.
- Information about COVID-19 vaccination status.
- Information about permanent residence and temporary address in St. Petersburg during the EAWF 2021.

Foreign citizens arriving from abroad to attend the EAWF 2021 must upload a document (in Russian or English) confirming negative results from a PCR test for COVID-19 taken no earlier than 72 hours before arrival in Russia, indicating which country they arrived into Russia from in order to attend the Forum.

TEST RESULTS

PCR test results from EAWF 2021 will be automatically uploaded into the accreditation system, and a negative PCR test result will activate your site access badge. Without a negative PCR test result, the accreditation badge is not valid.

Before travelling to the Forum venue, please ensure that your test result is negative and your badge is active. You can verify the information in one of the following ways:

- A mark of readiness in your personal web office
- By calling the Forum information centre at +7 (812) 406 7470
- By calling a Roscongress Foundation specialist

The results of PCR tests will be sent to all participants in Russian and English. Foreign participants can present them when crossing the border and upon arrival in their country of residence.

CULTURAL PROGRAMME ACTIVITIES

Guests will be admitted using their active badges or special invitations upon presentation of a negative PCR test result for COVID-19 to the staff at the checkpoint.

PROCEDURES FOR PCR TESTING OF DRIVERS

Drivers of accredited vehicles will undergo PCR testing exclusively at the Forum PCR testing centres. PCR tests may not be taken at other locations.

Testing must be completed no earlier than 08:00 10 October and no later than 24 hours before arrival at the Forum venue.

The activation of the badge takes place automatically when a negative result is received. The badge is activated for the entire Forum period.

Collecting badges and participant bags

An activated accreditation badge is required to enter the third Eurasian Women's Forum venue. **An accreditation badge is invalid without a negative PCR test result.**

The badge is personalized and may not be transferred to third parties. Participants must have their badge and identity document (passport) with them at all times while at the Forum venue.

If the accreditation badge is lost or damaged, please go to the Help Desk or any accreditation stand.

A badge is ready to be collected, if:

- The attendee has confirmed their participation in the Forum through their <u>personal web</u> office
- The data registered in the personal web office exactly match the data in their identification document (passport)
- A badge photo has been uploaded to the personal web office (colour photograph, 480x640 pixels, JPG or JPEG format; the subject must be facing straight forward in front of a light background, they must not be wearing a head covering, and the face must take up at least 70% of the photo)
- The personal data for accreditation has been processed

When you go to collect your badge, the accreditation operator will compare the data in your personal web office against the identification document provided. If the data do not match, you will not be able to collect the associated badge the same day. Please review your personal data in your personal web office before collecting your badge.

DOCUMENTS FOR COLLECTING BADGES AND PARTICIPANT BAGS

Participant badges and bags can be collected in person or by proxy (with a power of attorney) at the Accreditation Centre (Tavricheskiy Palace, 47, Shpalernaya Street). The participant bag will be provided when the participant badge is issued.

Badges and participant bags can be collected in person, upon presentation of:

- An identification document matching the data registered in the personal web office
- An original copy of the consent to processing of personal data form

Badges and participant bags can also be collected by proxy, upon presentation of:

- Their passport
- The original copy of a standard power of attorney form
- A list of all participants whose badges are being collected by proxy and a copy of each of their passports
- An original copy of each participant's signed consent to processing of personal data form

ACCESS TO THE FORUM VENUE FOR CHILDREN AGES 5 TO 15

Individuals ages 5 to 15 can enter the venue by presenting an accreditation badge and only when accompanied by an accredited adult.

Accreditation of personal vehicles

Forum participants may obtain accreditation for a personal vehicle free of charge in order to access the Forum venues. Accreditation requests will be accepted until 11 October 2021.

Accredited vehicles have the right to access the following locations:

- Pick-up / drop-off zones near Tavricheskiy Palace, the Parliamentary Centre, and the Universe of Water museum complex (vehicles should not stop for more than 20–30 seconds for pick-up / drop-off)
- Parking areas for accredited vehicles near the Forum venues
- The first line and the parking area of Pulkovo Airport
- Pick-up / drop-off zones and parking areas at cultural programme event locations

The discussions, thematic sessions, strategic sessions, and analytical sessions have been grouped into five main categories.

The Women's Mission to Shape a New Agenda for Peace and Trust will focus on female participation in the diplomatic sphere, as well as in efforts to forge the Greater Eurasian Partnership.

The Women's Mission to Come Together for a Healthy Society will seek answers concerning the role played by women in securing a healthy future, and opportunities available to them. It will also look at new effective technologies, as well as mechanisms and approaches to promote healthy lifestyles.

Environmental and climate-related issues will come under the spotlight at events held as part of the platform **The Women's Mission to Protect the Planet: The Philosophy of Conscious Consumption and an Environmentally Friendly Future**.

Platforms – The Women's Mission to Achieve Social Transformation and The Women's Mission to Achieve Digitalization and Economic Development – will focus on changes taking place in society, increasing female participation in fast-growing sectors of the economy, the development of the creative economy, and increasing financial and digital literacy.

A number of sessions will take place under the theme **Women in Agribusiness**. These will attempt to identify which agricultural projects are in greatest demand in the international investment market, and ascertain the future of agricultural professions.

As in previous editions of the Forum, expert sessions featuring international organizations and associations will form a key part of the programme. These will include a session of the Women20, a session of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO), a World Bank session, and a presentation of the BRICS Women's Business Alliance.

Among the events taking place for the first time at the Eurasian Women's Forum will be a meeting of the international club of winners and participants of APEC's international competition for women's projects (APEC BEST AWARD), and a meeting of the OECD Nuclear Energy Agency international working group on improving the gender balance in the nuclear sector.

TRANSPORT SERVICES

Getting to the hotels from your point of arrival

St. Petersburg's transport infrastructure is highly developed. The city has a public transport network and a large number of private vehicles and taxis.

METRO

The metro is the most popular and fastest mode of public transport.

A single journey costs RUB 60, regardless of the journey length or number of transfers between lines. In order to pay for your journey at the metro ticket offices you must purchase a token for a single trip or a reusable travel document, which varies in price depending on the period of validity and number of journeys.

OVERGROUND PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Overground transport includes buses, trolleybuses and trams. A single journey costs RUB 55 regardless of the journey length. You can pay the conductor or driver for your ride on board.

ORDERING TAXIS

All major taxi companies operate in St. Petersburg. You can also order a taxi by calling a transport operator or using a taxi booking form on the operator's website. For safety reasons we recommend using a major taxi company.

GETTING TO THE HOTELS FROM PULKOVO AIRPORT

Pulkovo Airport is located 17 kilometres from the historic centre of St. Petersburg and the majority of hotels. The closest metro station to Pulkovo Airport is Moskovskaya. You can take the number 39 bus from the airport to the metro.

You can use the taxi stands to order a taxi from Pulkovo Airport and St. Petersburg's rail terminals. The Taxi Pulkovo stands are located in the baggage claim area and the arrivals hall of the airport, and there are a number of taxi kiosks outside. Taxi Pulkovo rates can be found on the <u>Pulkovo</u> <u>Airport website</u>.

The journey time from Pulkovo to the hotels in the city centre is between 30 and 60 minutes depending on traffic, which can also affect routes.

All rail terminals are located in close proximity to metro stations.

Car rental

Participants of the third Eurasian Women's Forum can rent an accredited chauffeur-driven car.

The price of the transport service includes:

- Vehicle accreditation
- All costs for refuelling and washing the car
- Disinfection and treatment of the vehicle in accordance with Rospotrebnadzor recommendations and regulations, including personal protective equipment (PPE)
- 24-hour communication with the dispatcher and consultation with the participant in regards to the operation of the vehicle and driver

The minimum rental time for a chauffeur-driven vehicle is three days of twelve (12) hours a day.

In order to apply for a rental car, the participant must go to the 'Car rental' section of the <u>personal web</u> <u>office</u>, download and complete the rental application, and then email it to <u>autobooking@2021.eawf.ru</u>.


